LETTER OF INSTRUCTIONS

PURPOSE

The Fort Washington (MD) Alumni Chapter, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. has established a merit scholarship to promote academic excellence among male high school **seniors**. The following scholarship is awarded annually on a competitive basis, to male students graduating from high schools in the southern portion of the state of Maryland:

The **McKinley M. Hayes Scholarship** is awarded to a highly-motivated male graduating senior with an outstanding academic achievement record, strong leadership qualities, and involvement in school/community activities.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the **McKinley M. Hayes Scholarship**, applicants must:

1. Be a male graduating senior.
2. Be a resident of the southern portion of the state of Maryland.
3. Be accepted for admission to a post-secondary institution of higher learning.
4. Have demonstrated an excellent record of conduct, leadership potential, civic, and community involvement.

HOW TO APPLY

To enter the competition for the scholarship, applicants must submit:

1. A completed **typed** application form.
2. An official high school transcript and SAT/ACT scores.
3. Two letters of recommendation as stipulated in part E, paragraph 2 of the application form.
4. Affix a current photograph (2" x 3") to the first page of the application form.

The above documents, which constitutes a complete application package, must be submitted to the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee at the address shown on the application form and be received no later than **15 March 2010**. Incomplete application packages not received by this date will not be considered.
